## 2017 Quinault Perch Sport Fishing Season Regulation - 03 June 27, 2017

### The 2017 Quinault Perch Sport Fishing Season Regulation

**Area:** The Quinault Indian Nation beaches are open to hook and line fishing but the area between Pt. Grenville and the mouth of the Quinault River shall be closed to guided perch fishing by non-enrolled Quinault fishers from June 29<sup>th</sup> to July 6<sup>th</sup>.

**Bag Limit:** 15 perch per fishermen.

**Gear:** Each fisher is limited to the use of one fishing pole.

**Restrictions:** All non-enrolled Quinault fishers must be accompanied by an enrolled Quinault tribal member while fishing.

**Season:** The perch season will run from January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup> 2017.

**All non-enrolled Quinault fishers must obtain a \$10.00 day permit.** Permits may be obtained at the Taholah Mercantile.

**A \$25 minimum fee per non-enrolled Quinault fishers shall be charged by the enrolled Quinault Tribal Guides.**

There will be a limit of 5 non-enrolled Quinault fishers per enrolled Quinault tribal member.

All individuals, including guides, who participate in this fishery, must fulfill all requirements of eligibility described in Title 51.

**Catch Reporting:** All catches must be reported as required by Title 51.

A list of fishing guides can be obtained from the Fish & Game Office.

**Guides are responsible for litter cleanup at fishing locations**
