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## QUINAULT BUSINESS COMMITTEE RESOLUTION NO. 20 - 291 - 98

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### A RESOLUTION REVISING THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE THIRD INCIDENT COMMAND TEAM

**WHEREAS**, the Quinault Business Committee is the recognized governing body of the Quinault Indian Nation under the authority of the Quinault Indian Nation's Constitution adopted by the Quinault General Council on March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1975; and

**WHEREAS**, the Quinault Indian Nation has inherent sovereign governmental powers to protect and promote the health, safety and general welfare of the people of the Quinault Nation; and

**WHEREAS**, under Article I, Section 2 of the Quinault Constitution, the Business Committee is empowered to provide for the general safety and welfare of all persons acting by the right of membership in the Quinault Nation or acting or residing within the jurisdiction of the Quinault Nation ("Quinault Community"); and

**WHEREAS**, per Resolution # 20-55-98, as duly adopted by the Business Committee on March 13, 2020, the Nation declared a Public Health Emergency for the Quinault Reservation in response to the global outbreak of the Coronavirus epidemic ("COVID-19"); and

**WHEREAS**, on March 16, 2020, the Business Committee activated the QIN Emergency Operation Center (EOC) and established the Incident Command Team (ICT) to manage the Nation's response to the Covid-19 Pandemic and protect the Nation's people; and

**WHEREAS**, the ICT's goals and objectives were to address the needs, safety, and health of the Quinault Nation and provide the Business Committee with policy and financial recommendations to manage the Nation through the pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the first ICT was demobilized on June 30, 2020, and a second ICT (ICT 2) was mobilized in August, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, ICT 2 is scheduled to demobilize on October 30, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 12, 2020, by Resolution No. 20-288-98, the Business Committee appointed members to the third Incident Command Team (ICT 3), which will launch on October 30, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to that appointment, some members are unable to serve on the ICT 3, and some adjustments are necessary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that, effective October 19, 2020, the Quinault Business Committee appoints the following persons to the third Incident Command Team:
