

Construction of New Storage Shed at QIN Seed Orchard

Project Description

Construction of a new storage shed at the QIN Seed Orchard.

Qualifications Desired

- a) Proven track record of supplying and completing and repairing pole buildings
Washington State licensed general contractor

Scope of Work

Plans or design a for and Construction of:

30' x 30' Storage shed, 12 foot eaves, see attached drawing (stick built or pre-fab, wood or metal frame), 29 gauge (before coating) metal siding and roofing, unfinished interior

3 sides closed and 1 side open with 2 open 15-foot bays (see diagram)

End panels and 1 foot on top of each wall to have siding (plastic or fiberglass) that allows light to enter building (see photos)

Vinyl backed insulated ceiling

Gutters front and back

Site prep and gravel prep for cement floor

6' reinforced cement floor, rebar 1' on center

Plumb existing fixture in back of shed with 40'x24' shop tub with legs (see photos)

Plus provide and installation of:

- 2-300 watt solar back up power kits.

- 4-deep cycle batteries, power sonic brand, sealed maintenance free, long shelf life, high discharge rate.

- 4-pluggable led light

Location: QIN Seed Orchard, 5 miles from 109 up Moclips Highway

On site power supply is a Honda EB11000 generator, water comes from a well and is not potable.

Project Schedule

Work shall commence once the QIN contracting officer provides the contractor with a written notice to proceed and shall continue based on a time schedule submitted by the contractor to the QIN contracting officer no more than 5 business days after award of the contract. All work must be completed by 9-15-2017.

Proposal requirements

A written bid with amounts for each item in the scope of work including mobilization and a total, along with a statement of qualifications must be submitted to Jim Hargrove by mail, email, or hand delivery by close of business 7-7-2017. Contractor’s ability to perform the work in the desired timeline will be addressed in the bid.

Criteria for Selection

Selection will be based on reputation and qualifications. Contractors with similar qualifications will be evaluated based on bid cost transparency and low-bid.

Notice to Proceed

THE CONTRACTOR MAY NOT BEGIN WORK UNTIL THE CONTRACT IS FULLY SIGNED BY ALL QIN-REQUIRED SIGNATORIES.

Terms of Payment

Contractor shall be paid the agreed-upon bid price upon successful completion of the project as determined by the QIN contracting officer, Jim Hargrove.

Do not include sales taxes in the bid. Purchases are tax exempt under Washington Administrative Code Section 458-20-192- Sales to Indians.

Contract Requirements

Successful bidder must execute the attached standard contract with the Nation prior to commencement of services.

Checklist of Other Requirements

1. Permitting

For this project, all Federal and Tribal environmental and building permits will be the responsibility of the Nation. The contractor will be responsible for complying with all permit provisions (e.g. hydraulic work windows, in-stream project activities, hatchery water supply maintenance, etc...). A copy of each permit will be provided to the contractor. A copy must be kept on site through the duration of the project.

2. Business License

All Contractors working on-Reservation must obtain a Quinault Indian Nation business license. Application included in bid documents.

3. Certification Regarding Debarment

All Contractors must submit a Certification Regarding Debarment within 10 days of signing contract. This Certificate

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must be renewed annually. Blank form included in bid documents.

4. Federal Form W-9

All Contractors must submit a Form W-9 within 10 days of signing contract. Blank form included in bid documents.

5. Written proof of insurance

All Contractors must submit a certificate of insurance from their insurance carrier as per the requirements in the Contract.

6. TERO Compliance. See the attached Indian Preference Policy, which applies to this project. A TERO Compliance Plan must be submitted and TERO fees may apply. The Quinault Indian Nation has adopted the State of Washington prevailing wages, which apply to this project.

7. Proof of registration with applicable state Labor & Industries Department

Corporations with employees must submit proof that L&I insurance payments (worker's compensation insurance) are current before retainage is released.

Washington sole proprietors, and corporations that are exempt from paying L&I insurance for officers (corporations without employees) must register with the Washington State Department of Labor & Industries and claim no employees.

Indian-owned businesses doing work on the Reservation using all Indian employees are exempt from Washington State Labor & Industries registration. They must submit proof of private worker's compensation insurance in lieu of registration with Washington State L&I.

8. Proof of registration with applicable state Employment Security Department

Contractors with employees must submit proof from Washington Employment Security Department that State Unemployment Insurance is paid up before retainage is released.

Contractors without employees must register with ESD and claim no employees. Contractors may contact the Washington Employment Security Department at **360-902-9626** to request a letter confirming registration. Washington Corporations may file a letter with the Washington Employment Security Department to exempt officers from paying state employment taxes. Any Washington corporation that claims it is exempt from paying state employment taxes must provide the Nation a copy of the letter filed with the Washington Employment Security Department.

This RFB does not commit QIN to award a contract, to pay any cost incurred in preparation of a response to this invitation, or to procure or contract for services or supplies. Bidders will not offer any gratuities, favors, or anything of monetary value to any employee, officer, or agent of the Nation for the purpose of influencing favorable disposition toward either their proposal or any other proposal submitted as a result of this RFB. All proposals submitted hereunder become the exclusive property of the Nation. We reserve the right to accept all or part, or to decline the whole bid.
