The Quinault Indian Nation is seeking bids for demo, removal and proper disposal of old 12” steel header piping and installation of new large-scale piping and valve systems in a range of sizes including 10”, 8”, 6” and 4” steel and PVC at Lake Quinault Tribal Fish Hatchery. All described work is within the Quinault Indian Reservation and will be completed by September 10th 2018.
