

# Request for Proposal

## Temporary Assistance for Needy Families

TANF is requesting proposals for a cook to prepare a traditional meal for a potlatch for approximately 150 attendees that will be held at our Youth Summer Camp in Shelton, WA on July 13, 2022 @ 5PM.

The cook or team of cooks will present a culturally relevant menu with the proposal. Once approved, you will be given a PO to shop for the items needed to prepare the meal as listed on the menu that was submitted with the proposal (drinks will be provided by the camp). The meal will be prepared in the camp kitchen and the team will have full use of cooking utensils and dishes located at camp. After the meal is prepared, the cooking team will set out the meal for campers. The cook(s) will also be responsible for cleanup of the cooking area; all cleaning supplies needed are located at camp and will be available for the team to use. Proposal should include costs for everything in the scope of work.

Please submit a food handler's card and an explanation of your experience working with large groups with your proposal. The approved team must be able to pass a WSP background check. The approved team will sign the Quinault Nation contract. Proposals are due by June 10<sup>th</sup> 2022 to [bids@quinault.org](mailto:bids@quinault.org).

The team selected must submit a Form W-9 prior to the event in order to receive payment.

Indian Preference applies to all contract procurement with the QIN. The determination of who is an Indian Contractor is made by the Tribal Employment Rights Office according to Quinault Tribal Code, Title 97. Indian Contractors must provide certification from the Tribal Employment Rights Office in order to be considered eligible for Indian Preference.
