**Project Description:** Cook traditional foods lunch for 25 people. Lunch served at 1pm at Generations Building.

### Scope of Work:

- Prep, cook and serve lunch.
- Menu
  - Blueback Fish
  - Clam Chowder
  - Fry Bread
  - Baked Beans
  - Mac or Potato Salad
  - Dessert
  - Assorted Drinks
- Responsible for all food shopping, supply shopping: plates, napkins, silverware, etc.
- Set up of food – setting up food line
- If used, cleaning of kitchen after event (wiping counters, sweeping, mopping, no food left in fridges, etc.)

### Qualifications:

- Food handlers permit for all that will be prepping, cooking and serving food
- Has a business license with QIN
- Indian Preference

### Include in BID:

- Cost for total scope of work.
- If bidders are Quinault (with enrollment number), Supporting Quinault, Other Indian (enrollment), or Other.

Preference will be given to inclusion of qualified Indian-owned firms per the QIN’s Indian Preference Policy. Respondents must not have been suspended or debarred by the federal government. The Nation’s Indian Preference Policy applies (attached). The determination of who is an Indian Contractor is made by the Tribal Employment Rights Office according to Quinault Tribal Code, Title 97. Indian Contractors must provide certification from the Tribal Employment Rights Office in order to be considered eligible for Indian Preference. **A TERO fee may be assessed.** This RFB does not commit QIN to award a contract, to pay any costs incurred in preparation of a response to this invitation, or to procure or contract for services or supplies. Respondents will not offer any gratuities, favors or anything of monetary value to any employee, officer, or agent of the Nation for the purpose of influencing favorable disposition toward either their proposal or any other proposal submitted as a result of this RFB. All proposals submitted hereunder become the exclusive property of the Nation. The Nation reserves the right to accept all or part of the bid, or to decline the whole proposal.
