QBC is requesting proposals for two cooks to prepare fish for approximately 400 attendees that will be held at Pt. Haynisisoos in Taholah, WA on August 26, 2022 @ 11:00AM.

The cook or team of cooks will present a menu including traditionally cooked fish over a fire on sticks. Once approved, you will be given a PO to shop for the items needed to prepare the meal as listed on the menu that was submitted with the proposal, including plates and utensils. QIN will purchase the fish through Quinault Pride Seafood. One cook will be at Pt. Haynisisoos and the other at the Taholah Memorial Park if more cooking space is needed. The cooks will be responsible for gathering, providing, and preparing supplies to cook the meal. After the meal is prepared, the cooking team will deliver and set out the meal for attendees. The cook(s) will also be responsible for cleanup of the cooking area; Proposal should include costs for everything in the scope of work.

Please submit a food handler’s card and an explanation of your experience working with large groups with your proposal.

The approved team will sign the Quinault Nation contract.

The team selected must submit a Form W-9 prior to the event in order to receive payment and acquire a Quinault Business License.

Indian Preference applies to all contract procurement with the QIN. The determination of who is an Indian Contractor is made by the Tribal Employment Rights Office according to Quinault Tribal Code, Title 97. Indian Contractors must provide certification from the Tribal Employment Rights Office in order to be considered eligible for Indian Preference.
