

## **Request for Proposal Behavioral Health Taholah Suicide Prevention Meal**

Behavioral Health program is requesting proposals for a cook to prepare a family night meal for approximately 100 attendees that will be held at Taholah Community Center on September 20, 2022 @ 6PM.

The cook will present a menu, copy of valid food handler's card, and a copy of QIN Business License with the proposal.

If approved, you will be given a PO to shop for the items needed to prepare the meal as listed on the menu that was submitted with the proposal.

The meal will be prepared in the community center building kitchen, if needed, on the day of the event. Cook will use own cooking and serving equipment. Please note that food will be in a PO thus the cost of food should not be part of your bid.

Once the meal is prepared, the cook will set out the meal for families.

The cook will be responsible for cleanup of the cooking area. Proposal should include the costs for everything in the scope of work.

To be considered all requirements must be included. Experience working with large groups is a plus but a time when you delivered great service under pressure may be included with your proposal. The team selected must submit a Form W-9 prior to the event in order to receive payment. The approved team will sign the Quinault Nation contract.

Indian Preference applies to all contract procurement with the QIN. The determination of who is an Indian Contractor is made by the Tribal Employment Rights Office according to Quinault Tribal Code, Title 97.

Indian Contractors must provide certification from the Tribal Employment Rights Office in order to be considered eligible for Indian Preference.
