

Quinault Indian Nation, Tribal Biomass District Heating Facility Request for Proposals

The Quinault Indian Nation (QIN) is soliciting proposals from qualified Architecture and Engineering Firms in support of the Design and Engineering of a Tribal Biomass District Heating Facility to be located on or near the Quinault Indian Reservation (QIR) in Washington State.

Project Scope Overview:

Prepare Construction Documents suitable for bidding and construction of a commercially viable Tribal Biomass District Heating Facility, with a boiler designed to use biomass such as logging residue (slash) that has been ground and/or chipped as primary feedstock. Facility siting, sizing, and cost will all require close management and control so that the final Facility design will construct a profitable and successful operation. **Therefore, it is critical to this project that the selected Engineering Firm provide a Biomass District Heating Facility Operations subject matter expert from start to completion of this project to ensure proper engineering and design of a fully functional QIN Biomass District Heating Facility.**
