

# QIN Demonstration/Rally at Hoquiam City Hall – NO Crude Oil in Grays Harbor BOAT INFORMATION – JULY 8<sup>th</sup>

## SCHEDULE:

**10:30** Volunteers arrive to assist boaters getting in the water

**10:30 – 11:15** arrive at 28<sup>th</sup> St. Boat Launch

**11:30** Launch and paddle to N.W. end of Rennie Island near the mouth of the Hoquiam River; make a flotilla of boats until all participants are gathered

**12:30** Boat parade begins, led by tribal canoes up the Hoquiam River to [9<sup>th</sup> St. Dock](#) at 9<sup>th</sup> St. and Levee

**1:30** Landing at 9<sup>th</sup> St. Dock  
Traditional canoes will land first with Lay-cho-ese canoe from Queets in lead, then Pacific Rooster boat flying Quinault flag and tribal fishing boats, then kayaks and other boats

**2:45** March to Hoquiam City Hall – (9<sup>th</sup> St. to Simpson to 8<sup>th</sup> St. between “L” and “M” Streets

**3:00** Rally at Hoquiam City Hall

**4:00** SEAFOOD MEAL Provided by Quinault Nation – location TBD

**HOQUIAM TIDES:** low tide -.6 feet at 10:36 am, hi tide +9.3 at 5:24 pm

## [28<sup>th</sup> Street Boat Launch](#)

**Directions:** In East Hoquiam, E on Simpson Ave.; R at 28th St; follow .5 mi to end at parking area/boat ramp. It is Okay to park along road.

Sanicans will be available.



Levee St. will be closed to through traffic between noon and 6 pm

The paddle from the 28<sup>th</sup> Street Boat Launch to the N.W. end of Rennie Island is about one mile where we will rendezvous with tribal canoes, other tribal boats, and fishing boats. The paddle from the rendezvous to the 9<sup>th</sup> St. Dock up the Hoquiam River is about 1.25 miles and will be led by the Traditional tribal canoes.

The tribal canoes, with the Lay-cho-ese canoe from Queets going first, will lead the boat parade. All the tribal canoes will land first, followed by the Quinault boat Pacific Rooster flying the Quinault flag. After all tribal boats have landed or anchored, the kayaks and other boats are welcome to land at the 9<sup>th</sup> St. Dock.

We will have folks watching the kayaks during the March and will shuttle people back to the 28<sup>th</sup> St. Boat Launch at the end of the Rally. There will be sanicans at the 9<sup>th</sup> St. Dock. **Please do not use Swanson's parking lot or bathrooms.**
