Past due rent or utility bills?

Emergency Rental Assistance (ERAP) funding is provided through the federal CARES Act and is intended to help pay for either past due, current, and future rent or utilities.

Enrolled QIN Applicants will:

- *Meet low income guidelines*
- *Reside within Washington State*
- *Need assistance with rent and/or utilities*
- *Complete an application to submit with supporting documentation*
